



Skills and labour shortages in the EU



74% of EU SMEs say they face skills shortages



90% of jobs demand digital skills, but only 56% Europeans have basic proficiency



3x more labour shortages in manufacturing and construction than 10 years ago





50% more labour shortages in services than 10 years ago



1 million fewer workers every year until 2050




15 MS set-up Individual Learning Accounts since 2022



Helping businesses find the workers they need

- Action plan to tackle skills and labour shortages.
- Effective Active Support to Employment (EASE) to facilitate job transition.
- Talent and Skills Mobility Package to attract international talent and promote intra-EU mobility.
- **EU Talent Pool** to recruit non-EU workers and address labour shortages.
- European approach to Micro-credentials





Investing in skills

2030 target: at least 60% of adults in training every year



The EU invests around €65 billion in training.




3.5 million people received training through the **Pact for Skills** in 2022 and 2023.



€691 million from the European Globalisation Adjustment Fund for Displaced Workers have helped over 168,000 people since 2007.







Helping young people enter the job market

Youth Employment Support



50 million young people in Youth Guarantee secured jobs, apprenticeships, traineeships, or continued education and training



2.5 million apprenticeship placements through the European Alliance for Apprenticeships



68% of young trainees say they found a job after completing a traineeship




