Members of the Pact have access to **knowledge** on upskilling and reskilling needs, advice on relevant **funding instruments** to boost the skills of adults in their regions and countries, and **partnership opportunities** within our growing community.








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Overlapping ecosystems







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The Proximity and Social Economy Large Scale Partnership (P&SE LSP)

- Launched at the Strasbourg Conference Social Economy: the Future of Europe (February 2022)
- First Declaration presented and validated at the Conference
- Initially co-coordinated by Social Economy Europe (SEE) and European Venture Philanthropy Association (EVPA)
- Euricse (European Research Institute on Cooperative and Social Enterprises) replaced EVPA in February 2023







LSP Declaration – objectives

- Concrete and realistic plan and commitments
- Existing Blueprint and other EU funded projects as a starting point
- Identify statistical information and key areas on the upskilling and reskilling in the ecosystem
- Support the objective that by 2030 at least 5% of the proximity and social economy ecosystem workforce will participate in upskilling or reskilling actions each year.
